Dear Parents/Carers,

Reception and Keyworker Opening – 8th June.

I write to confirm that we will be open on 8th June 2020 to reception and keyworker children.

The Local Authority have signed off all risk assessments and everything is complete, ready to open.

- We will be open to keyworker children that have confirmed places with us.
- We will be open to 'vulnerable' children, such as those with an EHCP.
- We will be open to reception class children (RDJ and REW).
- We are closed to all others.

- We've already received responses from two-thirds of reception parents indicating that they will be coming in which is great. If you intend to send your child in and you have not been in contact, you must email us. headteacher@ravensdale.coventry.sch.uk

- All places offered are full time, 5-days-a-week, 08:45-15:15. You may enter informally from 08:30-09:00 and collect between 15:00 and 15:30.

- Children of keyworkers that are already attending do not need to get in touch again.

- The school is clearly signposted: please follow the signs on entry and the one-way system.

Entry & Exit (signs will be in place):

Reception children will use the main entrance.

Keyworker children in years N,1,2,3 will enter via the year 1 and 2 classrooms.

Keyworker children in years 4,5,6 will enter via the blue Key Stage 2 entrance next to year 4 classrooms.

Full uniform is expected, and a school meal is available if you notify staff. Please bring the minimum equipment into school. Note that children will be placed into a "pod" of 10 on entry and this may not be with usual class teachers.

For others:

If the current guidelines do not change, it is very unlikely we will be able to expand our opening further. Therefore, it is very unlikely that we will open to years 1-6 soon, unless the government guidelines change.
