### Dinners—September 2019

#### Reception-Year 2:

Children from Reception to the end of year 2 will receive free school meals.

#### Year 3-Year 6

If you require your child to have a school meal from September, payment of £2.20 per day (£11.00 per week) must be made in advance at the start of each week. One weeks notice must be given if you wish to change your child's meal type during the school year.

### Absence and Sickness

Please can we remind you to phone in on the first morning of absence.

On your child's return a written letter will be required for the school office. In the event of diarrhoea or vomiting, please allow 48 hours from the last episode before returning to school.

### Starting Primary School in September 2020

If you have a child in Nursery or know of a child born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2016, they will be due to start school in September 2020.
